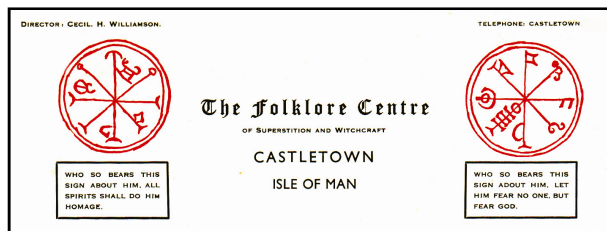

Letterhead from the original 'Museum of Witchcraft' in the Isle of Man

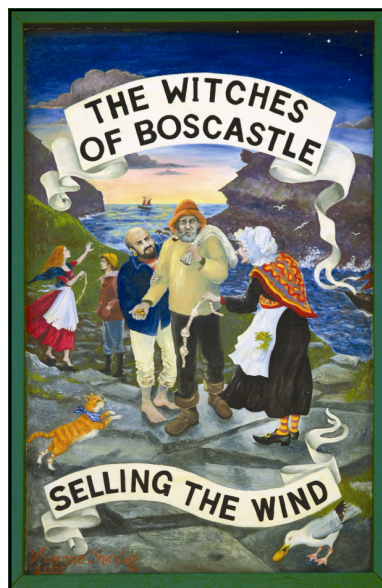
